**MST Poll Background:**

*This poll was conducted among a sample of 500 registered voters in the City of Manila, interviewed in-person from April 14-18, 2010. Multi-stage probability sampling was applied allocated into random samples proportional to the registered voter population of each of the six districts of Manila. This breakdown of sample sizes by district reflects the latest proportion of registered voters based on the February 2010 data of the COMELEC. The error due to sampling for results based on the city-wide sample is at plus or minus four percentage points. The error for subgroups is higher.*
