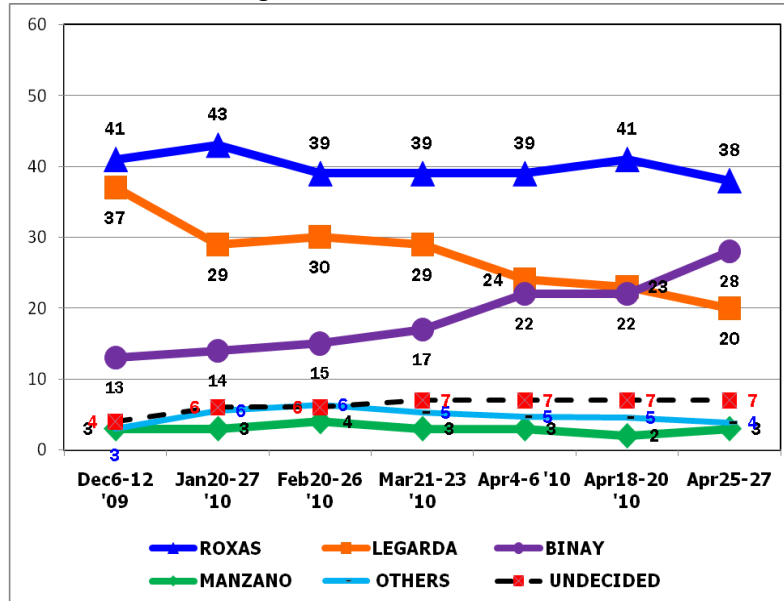

***MST Poll Background:***

*This poll was conducted among a statistically-representative sample of 2,500 registered voters nationwide, interviewed in-person from April 25-27, 2010. Multi-stage probability sampling was applied allocated into random samples of 300 in the National Capital Region, 550 in North & Central Luzon, 540 in South Luzon & Bicol, 510 in the Visayas and 600 in Mindanao. This breakdown of sample sizes by major areas reflects the latest proportion of registered voters (February 2010 data of the COMELEC). The error due to sampling for results based on the national sample is at plus or minus two percentage points. The error for subgroups is higher.*

*The registered voters were asked their intention to vote and only those who signified they definitely will vote in the May elections were asked to accomplish a ballot and shade the oval space which corresponds to their choices; after which their ballot is dropped in a box. This interview technique simulates what will happen during the computerized elections in May 10.*

***MST Poll Question Wording:***

*I have here a blank ballot. Please shade the oval which corresponds to the name of whom you would vote for PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT, 12 SENATORS OF THE PHILIPPINES and 1 PARTY-LIST GROUP if elections were held today? Please do not vote more than the allotted number for each position.*

*Please drop your ballot into this box so I will not be able to see what is in your ballot.*
